The BC Muslim Association (BCMA) Board of Education (BOE) is requesting proposals from qualified technology providers to propose an architecture solution and to deliver the chosen solution in a bid to upgrade its IT infrastructure.

Due to an expanded operation in 2 locations, Surrey Muslim School (SMS) and BC Muslim School (BCMS), the desired end state is that the sites would be able to freely and securely pass data and information amongst themselves, as well as operate independently if the need arises.

As an expert in the area of IT architecture, your proposal is expected to provide options for security, redundancy, scalability, and failover.

All vendors will provide their proposed architecture diagram with a legend for all appliances/materials required to deliver the architecture.

The winning bid will include

- The rationale supporting the solution’s efficiency and security measures
- The labour charges required to set-up and configure the appliances/materials to achieve the proposed architecture.
- How the solution optimizes the management of the domain objects/users
- Why the plan maximizes the ROI for investment in technology
- The cost to create handover documentation that will be provided for any IT service providers that may be engaged to maintain the solution
