## **BCMA EMERGENCY FLOOD RELIEF FOR BC**

**(Abbotsford, BC)** — The province of British Columbia declared a provincial state of emergency on Wednesday in order to provide additional resources to the continued effort to support the thousands of people affected.

A total of 17 regional districts were affected by floods, mudslides and landslides when about a month's worth of rain fell on that part of the province in about two days, Emergency Management BC said.

The BC Muslim Association is coordinating a community response to the historic flooding and damage that our province is facing.
